City of Thomasville, North Carolina Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Week January 9 – 15, 2024

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1983, Congress designated the third Monday in January as a federal holiday, and the first King Holiday was celebrated on January 20, 1986; and observed by a week of community activities since January, 2001, uniting government, business, civic organizations and houses of worship; and

WHEREAS, the Martin Luther King Social Action Committee, Inc., founded in 1993, advances and promotes the unfinished work of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. through teaching, advocating and promoting the non-violent elimination of poverty, racism and hate; and

WHEREAS, a local theme has been adopted for Thomasville's 38th annual Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday celebration – "Knowledge is Never Wisdom Until it is Shared"; and

WHEREAS, we, as individuals and as a community, must take a stand and continue to work together to make freedom, justice and equal opportunity a reality for all people.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Raleigh York, Jr., Mayor of the City of Thomasville, do hereby proclaim January 9 – 15, 2024 as:
