Hill.

Chairman Styers called the meeting to order. The minutes of November 9, 2015 were approved as presented.

1. Presentation by Vision Internet

Ms. Tricia Lease of Vision Internet explained that her company specializes in building websites for cities and counties and they have done so for the last 20 years. Vision takes a very consultative approach to what they do, working with a very intensive process involving staff. Ms. Lease said they look at the audience, who the people are, what they are searching for at the site and how they get to that information. They actually look through surveys and heat maps while conducting a very scientific process. A follow-up report showing what they generated and how they can build a custom design based off of that follows.

Mr. Lease said there are new innovative ways in which to interact with customers and lead them easily through a website which is accessible 24/7. The website should be designed to represent the cities' "X-Factor", the "brand and voice" which will show what we have to offer to increase quality of life for our citizens.

The purpose of an excellent government website is to do 3 things; serve, represent and delight. It is best to use plain language principles to ensure an easy and pleasant experience.

Staff directories are helpful, employment applications, links to inspectors, there are so many different ways in which to assist citizens. Channel 13 can be put anywhere it needs to be for convenience and for availability to those who may not have cable tv. The site can also be made multi-lingual.

Ms. Lease concluded by saying that Vision would provide a blueprint for the site and this is not just a 2 year process; Vision provides continuous updates including an optional redesign plan built in every 4 years. They believe in "Innovation for On-line Government."

Chairman Styers said Council needs to talk significantly about what they want in a website. He added that the city needs a way to communicate with citizens regarding business development and entrepreneurship.

DATE: January 19, 2016

The Historic Preservation Commission at its meeting on January 12, 2016 unanimously voted to recommend the attached proposed change to the Ordinance Creating the Historic Preservation Commission and forward it to the City Council Personnel Committee for action. If adopted by the City Council the proposed change will bring the Ordinance (Sec. 2-152) in line with the current NC General Statutes (Chapter 160A, Article 19, Part 3C, Section 160A-400.7 regarding Commission Membership details.)

The pertinent part of Section 160A-400.7 of the NC General Statutes currently reads as follows:

§ 160A-400.7. Historic Preservation Commission.

Before it may designate one or more landmarks or historic districts, a municipality shall establish or designate a historic preservation commission. The municipal governing board shall determine the number of the members of the commission, which shall be at least three, and the length of their terms, which shall be no greater than four years. A majority of the members of such a commission shall have demonstrated special interest, experience, or education in history, architecture, archaeology, or related fields. All the members shall reside within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality as established pursuant to G.S. 160A-360. The commission may appoint advisory bodies and committees as appropriate.

Attached is a copy of the most recent Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City that indicates the portion recommended to be deleted. This can be updated by deleting the indicated sentence and changing date and signatures at the bottom.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF THOMASVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

BE IT ORDAINED, That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Thomasville be amended in the following respects:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 2 (Administration), Article IV (Boards, Commissions, and Committees), Division 2 (Historic Preservation Commission), Section 2-152 (Membership: Terms of Office, Vacancies) be amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 2-152. Membership: Terms of Office, Vacancies.

The Historic Preservation Commission shall consist of nine members appointed by the City Council. All members shall reside within the zoning jurisdiction of the City. A majority of the members of the Commission shall have demonstrated special interest, experience or education in history, architecture, archaeology or related fields. The Commission shall serve without compensation. The Commission may appoint advisory bodies and committees as appropriate.

Members of the Commission shall serve terms of three years. Terms shall be staggered. Vacancies occurring during a three year term may be filled for the completion of such unexpired term. After serving two consecutive full three year terms a member shall be ineligible for reappointment until one calendar year has elapsed from the date of the termination of his or her second full three year term. Members shall serve until their successors are appointed.”


SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Thomasville.

North Carolina Memorandum

N.C. GEN. STAT. §160A-460. Definitions

The words defined in this section shall have the meanings indicated when used in this Part:

(1) "Undertaking" means the joint exercise by two or more units of local government, or the contractual exercise by one unit for one or more other units, of any power, function, public enterprise, right, privilege, or immunity of local government.

(2) "Unit," or "unit of local government" means a county, city, consolidated city-county, local board of education, sanitary district, facility authority created under Part 4 of this Article, special district created under Article 43 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes, or other local political subdivision, authority, or agency of local government.

N.C. GEN. STAT. §160A-461. Interlocal cooperation authorized.

Any unit of local government in this State and any one or more other units of local government in this State or any other state (to the extent permitted by the laws of the other state) may enter into contracts or agreements with each other in order to execute any undertaking. The contracts and agreements shall be of reasonable duration, as determined by the participating units, and shall be ratified by resolution of the governing board of each unit spread upon its minutes.

N.C. GEN. STAT. §143 129. Procedure for letting of public contracts.

(e) Exceptions. – The requirements of this Article do not apply to:

(3) Purchases made through a competitive bidding group purchasing program, which is a formally organized program that offers competitively obtained purchasing services at discount prices to two or more public agencies.




