Due to the Executive Order from Governor Cooper for residents to “Stay at Home” and to improve “Social Distancing” for both Davidson County Transportation System Route Drivers and County Residents riding our buses, the following Service Changes will be implemented:

1. As of Tuesday, April 14, 2020, Davidson County Transportation System will suspend the operations of the BLUE, ORANGE, GREEN, and RED Deviated Fixed Routes.
2. Davidson County Transportation System will still offer rides for Medical, Pharmacy, Food, Employment, and Laundromat trips to residents through a “Dial-A-Ride” service. Residents requesting a ride need to call our office at 336-242-2250 one business day prior to their desired trip. Residents will be restricted to one round-trip per day at a maximum of 3 days per week.

This change of service will remain in effect until the Governor removes the “Stay At Home” Executive Order.
