Library adds access to more services during Phase 2

[LEXINGTON, NC, May 22] – The Davidson County Public Library System will begin offering curbside delivery of the following services Tuesday: scanning, faxing, copying and printing.

In addition, staff will allow a limited number of patrons inside the branches to access public computers. Patrons will see measures in place to promote social distancing and the sanitizing of equipment between uses.

“We are glad to be able to further expand access to our services during Phase 2,” said Sheila Killebrew, library director. “We have been working hard to outfit our facilities and staff with personal protective equipment. The safety of our patrons and staff is important to us.”

The library will continue to lend physical materials via curbside pickup and quarantine returned materials for 72 hours before checking them back in. Those items will continue to appear on patron accounts for those three days. Patrons interested in ordering materials for pickup can do so through the online catalog or by calling a local branch.

Anyone wishing to access scanning, faxing, copying, and printing services should call their local branch to start the process. Access to library computers is limited to essential tasks such as job searches and applications, applying for unemployment or other forms of government assistance, and the completion of school assignments. Depending on the level of demand, time allowed on computers may be limited.

Hours of operation during Phase 2 will be the same for each location: 9 a.m.-5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday and 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Saturday. The Lexington Public Library is undergoing a renovation. Holds for patrons using that location will be available across the parking lot in the Library Annex.
